ORDER

On January 16, 2007, Khotol Service Corporation submitted a notice of appeal concerning a dispute over \$363.50 involving an outstanding invoice under its contract, DTCG84-01-C-AA8001, with the United States Coast Guard. The next day, the contractor notified the Board that this matter has been effectively resolved; it requests a dismissal without prejudice. With a submission dated February 2, 2007, the Government concurs with the requested dismissal. Pursuant to the request of the parties, this matter is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**. The dismissal becomes with prejudice on August 6, 2007, unless a request is received at the Board before that date to delay such a conversion.
