ORDER

On March 16, 2007, InterImage, Inc. appealed the contracting officer's deemed denial of its claim for \$270,217.54 plus interest, under order number SBAHQ05F0209. This order had been issued by the Small Business Administration (SBA) under multiple award schedule contracts GS-23F-8021H and GS-35F-5577H. The order was for support services for the Office of Disaster Assistance's organizational transformation in conjunction with its implementation of the Disaster Credit Management System.

On April 25, 2008, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss this appeal with prejudice, stating that they had entered into a settlement agreement.

Accordingly, this appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
