ORDER

OLS Trading, Inc. (appellant) appealed a decision of the contracting officer arising out of a contract between appellant and the General Services Administration (GSA or Government). Appellant contended that property it purchased (office equipment and furnishings) from GSA differed from the contract as to quantity of the purchase and as to the time frame of transfer. In initially processing the appeal, appellant raised the fact that the contracting officer's decision failed to include the required information as to the option to appeal to the United States Court of Federal Claims. Soon after docketing this matter, the lack of language as to the court was discussed with the parties, with appellant choosing to remain at the Board. Thereafter the parties engaged in settlement discussions.

The Board was notified verbally on October 16, 2007, that the parties had reached a settlement. In a letter dated October 24, 2007, between the parties, appellant advised the Government that it would sign the stipulation of settlement, once it received the agreed-to payment. The fully executed settlement, with signature by both parties, was received by the Board on January 30, 2008. The signed stipulation called for the appeal to be dismissed.

Accordingly, the appeal is **DISMISSED**.
