ORDER

OhioLink Corrections and Treatment, Inc. (appellant) filed this appeal with the Department of Transportation Board of Contract Appeals (DOTBCA),¹ from the denial by the contracting officer of its claim in excess of \$300,000, plus interest, under a contract that

required appellant to provide residential rooms and services to male and female federal offenders in the Toledo, Ohio, area.

In accordance with the request of the parties, the appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
