On July 31, 2008, the above-captioned claim for reimbursement of expenses related to official travel was filed with the Board. On September 15, 2008, the agency responded and advised that claimant would be reimbursed for the amount claimed. After several unsuccessful attempts to contact Mr. Beemer to verify that the claim had been resolved, the Board issued an order on December 16, 2008, asking claimant to confirm that he had been reimbursed fully for his travel expenses. By letter dated January 5, 2009, the agency advised the Board that claimant had been paid on or about September 22, 2008, and further confirmed that claimant does not intend to continue his claim. The agency also asked that the claim be dismissed.

Accordingly, this claim is dismissed.
