ORDER

The CFIDS Association of America (CFIDS) appealed a Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) contracting officer's final decision asserting that CFIDS overbilled the Government in the amount of \$233,711.15 under a contract for education, training, and strategy services. The contracting officer demanded that CFIDS repay this amount to the Government.

CFIDS has moved the Board to dismiss the appeal with prejudice, stating that the parties have settled all issues and amounts due as billed and paid, and that no further obligations or adjustments are necessary.

Accordingly, the appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.**
