The appellants, the University of Kansas and the University of Kansas Center for Research, Inc., filed appeals with this Board on December 18, 2009 (docketed as CBCA 1839) and June 18, 2010 (docketed as CBCA 2051), concerning patent ownership disputes arising under a contract, N01-CM-77017, with the Department of Health and Human Services through the National Institutes of Health and the National Cancer Institute.
