BORWICK, Board Judge.

This appeal involves a claim in the amount of \$5,293,015 for direct costs incurred pursuant to a task order for nursing services that appellant alleged it was obligated to pay when the task order was modified to add the requirements of the Service Contract Act of 1965, 41 U.S.C. §§ 351 *et seq.* (2006).

The parties have settled their dispute for \$5,293,015, inclusive of interest and attorney fees. The parties have requested that the Board adopt their settlement by decision pursuant to Rule 25(b) and have stated that neither party will seek reconsideration of, or relief from, the Board's decision and that neither party will appeal the decision.

Decision

Pursuant to the agreement of the parties and Rule 25(b), the Board adopts the parties' stipulation by decision. This appeal is **GRANTED** in the amount of \$5,293,015.
