ORDER

On November 22, 2010, Datanamics, Inc. appealed the final decision of a Department of the Treasury, Internal Revenue Service contracting officer denying Datanamics' request for equitable adjustment under task order numbers TIRNO-03-K-00498, TIRNO-07-K-00443, and TIRNO-06-K-00356 for webRTS/IPS operations maintenance and enhancement.

On February 3, 2011, Datanamics filed a motion to dismiss these appeals with prejudice, stating that the parties have executed a settlement agreement and that respondent consents to the motion.

Accordingly, these appeals are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.**
