On July 25, 2012, the Board received a notice of appeal from PRO-telligent LLC (contractor). The contractor maintains that a contracting officer had improperly terminated for default its contract, SAQMMA-10-C-0245, with the Department of State to provide guard services. On October 9, the Board received a motion to dismiss with prejudice; the parties have entered into a settlement agreement. Accordingly, the Board **DISMISSES WITH PREJUDICE** this appeal.
