ORDER

CDM Smith Inc. claimed that it was entitled to be paid an additional \$611,182.57 for work it performed under a contract with the Agency for International Development in the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste. The parties began settlement negotiations shortly after this appeal of an adverse contracting officer's decision was filed. They have now resolved their dispute, and the contractor has asked the Board to dismiss the appeal with prejudice to its reinstatement. The agency has no objection to the request.

Accordingly, the appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
