ORDER

Calcaterra Properties, L.P. appealed a General Services Administration contracting officer's decision which claimed \$19,130.41 as reimbursement for expenses the agency paid to repair property leased from the appellant. The parties resolved their dispute through mediation, with a Board judge serving as neutral. The appellant now moves us to dismiss the case with prejudice, stating that both parties have complied with the terms of the settlement agreement.

Accordingly, the case is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
