The General Services Administration (GSA) denied full payment to Pilot Air Freight Corp. (Pilot) for hundreds of shipments which Pilot asserted it had transported for Department of Defense (DoD) agencies. Through two separate filings, Pilot asked the Board to review GSA's determinations, contending that it had indeed provided the services for which it had billed.

In an effort to resolve the disputes, Pilot, GSA, and DoD representatives, over a period of many months, exchanged and reviewed documentation regarding the shipments at issue.

On September 30, 2008, Pilot filed a motion to dismiss the case. It advised the Board that a settlement had been reached.
