ORDER

On February 19, 2008, the Board docketed the appeal of Xerox Corporation (Xerox). Xerox alleged that the Government had not issued a decision on its claim for unpaid invoices, which had been submitted on October 3, 2006. The Government subsequently issued a decision on March 26, 2008.

Appellant moved to dismiss this appeal with prejudice by letter dated May 1, 2008, which represented that the Government had paid the amounts owed on the invoices.

Accordingly, the appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.**
