ORDER

The Catawba Indian Nation and the Indian Health Service, Department of Health and Human Services, entered into a cost reimbursement contract for health services in 1994. In 2004, the Indian Health Service issued a final decision in the amount of \$3,240,941.96 for charges not supported by check and for missing invoices, from which the Catawba Indian Nation filed these appeals.

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The parties have entered into a settlement agreement covering all issues involved in the above appeals and have filed a joint motion to dismiss with prejudice. That motion is granted. These appeals are hereby **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
