SOMERS, Board Judge.

On July 28, 2008, Lamar Life, LLC (Lamar Life) appealed the final decision of a General Services Administration (GSA) contracting officer terminating three leases under contract numbers GS-04B-47037, GS-04B-42051, and GS-04B-40155 for the lease of office space in the Lamar Life Building located at 317 East Capitol Street, Jackson, Mississippi; and on October 15, 2008, Lamar Life appealed the final decision of a GSA contracting officer denying Lamar Life's claim for damages arising from the termination of the three leases.

On August 27, 2009, the parties filed a motion for stipulated judgment and dismissal with prejudice, stating that, pursuant to the terms of an agreement settling the appeals, the parties jointly stipulated that judgment should be entered in favor of appellant in the amount of \$840,000 plus interest allowable under the Contract Disputes Act of 1978, 41 U.S.C. §§ 601-613 (CDA), to be computed from July 13, 2009.

The parties further certified that they shall not seek review or reconsideration of the judgment and that the parties waive their rights to reconsideration, to relief from judgment, and to appeal the decision.

Decision

These appeals are **GRANTED IN PART**. In accordance with the parties' motion for stipulated judgment and dismissal with prejudice, appellant is awarded \$840,000, plus interest allowable under the CDA to be computed from July 13, 2009.
