ORDER

Appellant, Fort Belknap Indian Community, appealed the decision of the respondent contracting officer's decision dated June 8, 2010, which issued audit determinations which disallowed \$676,578 in costs representing deferred revenue deficits identified in the audit, and demanded repayment of these costs by the appellant.

On December 9, 2010, the parties filed a settlement agreement and joint stipulation to dismiss, stating that all claims with regard to the appeal have been settled.

This appeal is, therefore, **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.**
