The claimant, Stephen K. Nemmer, disputes the denial of reimbursement for transporting his privately owned vehicle in connection with his change of permanent duty station within the continental United States (reporting date: November 8, 2010), when the departure point for the shipment of the vehicle was not his old duty station. The claimant was covered by a collective bargaining agreement that provides the exclusive method for resolving this dispute. The Board lacks authority to reach the merits and resolve the claim. *Daniel T. Garcia*, CBCA 2007-RELO (June 3, 2010) (Board determination of similarly situated employee under same agreement). The Board dismisses the case.
