ORDER

On June 25, 2010, Ascend Construction Management, Inc. (Ascend) appealed the deemed denial of a Department of Justice, Bureau of Prisons contracting officer concerning Ascend's claim under contract number DJB21103033 for the construction of the Witness Security Housing Unit at the Federal Correctional Institute in Otisville, New York.

On May 24, 2011, the parties filed a joint stipulation of dismissal with prejudice, stating that the parties have agreed to settle this matter and requesting that the appeal be dismissed with prejudice.

Accordingly, the appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.**
