On May 11, 2011, the Lovelock Paiute Tribe appealed the final decision of the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning the single audit report for the fiscal years ending December 31, 2005, and December 31, 2006. On October 31, 2011, respondent filed the signed settlement agreement, which stated, "When this Agreement is fully executed it will constitute a withdrawal with prejudice of Appellant's CBCA Appeal No. 2424-ISDA."
