Respondent, by notice of corrective action and motion to dismiss, advised that the Government had decided to pay appellant the total amount of its cost claim, i.e., \$1320. Since the Government had already withdrawn the deficiency citation that had been the subject of the instant appeal, the appeal has been rendered completely moot. Appellant had been afforded the opportunity to raise objection to respondent's motion and to provide any valid legal basis for proceeding with the appeal. It failed to do so.
