On July 9, 2012, through a filing by e-mail, claimant sought reconsideration of our decision in *Dana G. Kay*, CBCA 2506-RELO, 12-1 BCA ¶ 34,982. The Board issued that decision on March 21, 2012. There is a difference of 110 days or 3.6 months between the date our decision was issued and receipt of claimant's request for reconsideration. Board Rule 407 provides in pertinent part:

A request for reconsideration may be made by the claimant or the agency. Such requests must be received by the Board within 30 calendar days after the date the decision was issued.

Claimant's request is untimely, as it is 80 days late. Furthermore, in her reconsideration motion, claimant erroneously states that the Board neglected her "partial delivery" cost coverage claim. That claim was addressed, and denied, at page three of our decision.

Decision

Claimant's request for reconsideration is **DENIED**.
