This arbitration matter was brought on June 8, 2011, under the authority of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, Pub. L. No. 111-5, § 601, 123 Stat. 115, 164 (2009), and regulation, 44 CFR 206.209 (2010). The parties are the State of Louisiana, Office of Facility Planning and Control (applicant); the Louisiana Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (grantee); and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The applicant sought arbitration to resolve various disputes regarding the fuel shed, fuel dock and boat hoist located at the Pass-A-Loutre Water Fowl Management Area near Venice, Louisiana.

The parties have executed an arbitration agreement resolving this matter and on April 13, 2012, jointly moved to have the matter dismissed with prejudice.

Accordingly, the above-captioned arbitration is dismissed.
