ORDER

The Poarch Band of Creek Indians claimed that it was entitled to \$384,712 in unpaid contract support costs under a contract with the Indian Health Service, an entity within the Department of Health and Human Services. An appeal was taken from the contracting officer's deemed denial of the claim.

The parties represent that they have settled the dispute and have filed a joint stipulation of dismissal of the case with prejudice.

Accordingly, the case is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
