On September 30, 2013, the parties advised the Board that they had reached a settlement of the appellant's claim in the above-referenced appeal in the amount of \$6,300,000. In accordance with Rule 25(b) (48 CFR 6101.25(b) (2012)), the parties have jointly requested that the Board enter a judgment in the amount of \$6,300,000, which is inclusive of any costs and interest. Appellant has agreed not to seek attorney fees separately. The parties have further stipulated that they will not seek reconsideration of or relief from the Board's decision, and they will not appeal the Board's decision.

Decision

This appeal is **GRANTED IN PART** in the amount of \$6,300,000. Payment is to be made from the permanent indefinite judgment fund in accordance with 31 U.S.C. § 1304 (2006).
