ORDER

On April 10, 2013, Mather Enterprises (lessor) timely appealed a contracting officer decision concerning its contract, GS-V101-183R-760-005-01, with the Department of Veterans Affairs (agency). The agency occupied premises (warehouse, office, processing space, and parking) for a consolidated mail-out pharmacy. The contracting officer had denied the lessor's claim seeking \$520,897.80, as well as interest for various damages said to arise from the agency's multiple breaches of the contract. The parties utilized Board Judge Borwick as a neutral and resolved the dispute. Under a stipulation of settlement, the agency has paid the lessor \$100,000 and the parties have modified the contract. In accordance with a joint motion dated November 22, 2013, the Board hereby **DISMISSES WITH PREJUDICE** this appeal.
