ORDER

Rural Community Insurance Agency, Inc., doing business as Rural Community Insurance Services, appealed a determination of the Deputy Administrator of the Department of Agriculture's Risk Management Agency. The determination is that the company is liable for an overpaid indemnity in the amount of \$463,616 and a premium overstatement in the amount of \$12,950 with regard to the policy the company wrote for Jon A. Yori in Stanislaus, California, in 2007.

The parties have settled the case and ask the Board to dismiss it with prejudice. Accordingly, the case is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
