ORDER

St. Croix Chippewa Indians of Wisconsin, appellant, and the Department of Health and Human Services, respondent, ask the Board to dismiss with prejudice cases appellant brought before the Board involving contract support costs (CSCs) under contracts with respondent's Indian Health Service. The cases are CBCA 193-ISDA, involving CSCs for 1996; CBCA 298-ISDA, involving CSCs for 1997; CBCA 300-ISDA, involving CSCs for 1999; CBCA 301-ISDA, involving CSCs for 2002; CBCA 303-ISDA, involving CSCs for 2002; CBCA 304-ISDA, involving CSCs for 2003; and CBCA 305-ISDA, involving CSCs

for 2004.¹ The parties state that in making this request, they are acting pursuant to a settlement agreement which was executed on September 23, 2014.

The request is granted. The specified cases are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
