ORDER

The Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe of Michigan appealed a decision of a contracting officer of the Department of Health and Human Services' Indian Health Services which denied the appellant's claim for additional contract support costs under a contract for the provision of health care services in fiscal year 2007. The parties have settled their disputes and have jointly asked the Board to dismiss the appeal with prejudice to its reinstatement.
