ORDER

The Pueblo of Zuni contested the deemed denial by a contracting officer of the Department of Health and Human Services' Indian Health Service of a claim for unpaid contract support costs allegedly due in fiscal years 2002 through 2010 under Indian Self-Determination Act contracts. The parties have resolved their dispute and have jointly stipulated to the dismissal with prejudice of the appeal.
