Claimant, Teryl L. Stacey, requested the Board's review of the decision of the United States Army Corps of Engineers (the Corps) to disallow the amount of \$42,163.77, in expenses incurred in the performance of temporary duty (TDY) travel. This decision arose from an audit showing that claimant had exceeded 180 executive days of TDY. After the claim was docketed, the Corps undertook an internal review of the decision and agreed to approve the TDY retroactively and to halt its efforts to collect the disallowed amount. The Corps has filed a request to dismiss the claim, and Mr. Stacey has no objection to the request.

Accordingly, the claim is dismissed.
