ORDER

On April 22, 2014, the Board docketed an appeal from R.A. Glancy & Sons, Inc. (Glancy) regarding a dispute as to work at the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Medical Center in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. The matter was docketed as CBCA 3825. An initial review indicated that there had not been a demand for or a final decision issued by the contracting officer (CO) as to the disputed matter. The parties and Board conferred and as a result concluded that Glancy would proceed to seek a final decision from the CO, and the VA would then move to timely issue a final decision. Once the final decision was issued, appellant would elect whether to appeal or not, and if it chose to appeal, decide at what forum. Dismissal of CBCA 3825 was agreed to be held in abeyance until such time as a proper appeal on the matter was filed.

On August 11, 2014, Glancy filed a timely appeal from a decision of the CO dated July 31, 2014. That decision, which covers the same issues as CBCA 3825, was docketed as CBCA 4060. Accordingly and in accord with the earlier agreements, the appeal in CBCA 3825 is **DISMISSED**.
