ORDER

The Arctic Slope Native Association, Ltd. claimed entitlement to \$4,303,839 plus interest in underpaid contract support costs for fiscal years 2012 and 2013. A contracting officer of the Department of Health and Human Services' Indian Health Service denied the claims, and the Association appealed his decisions.

The parties have filed a joint stipulation of dismissal with prejudice, which states that the disputes between the parties as to these claims have been settled.

Accordingly, the appeals are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
