ORDER

In these five appeals, received on December 10, 2014, Pit River Health Service, Inc. sought contract support costs for five fiscal years, under Indian Self-Determination Act contracts with the Department of Health and Human Services. The parties resolved these disputes without formal proceedings. On January 8, 2015, the parties submitted to the Board a joint stipulation of dismissal with prejudice of each appeal, submitted pursuant to a settlement agreement between the parties.
