On October 21, 2015, the Board held a status conference by telephone with the claimant and representatives of the agency. After reviewing the twelve-hour rule of section C4552-F of the Joint Travel Regulations, it was agreed by the parties that the case be dismissed and the claimant will re-submit to the agency a supplemental voucher with supporting documentation (e.g., receipts, time-related records, and affidavit) for reimbursement of per diem for each day the claimant can show that his total time en route and duty period exceeded twelve hours.

The case is dismissed by agreement of the parties.
