ORDER

The Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe claimed entitlement to \$7790 plus interest in underpaid contract support costs for 1993. A contracting officer of the Department of Health and Human Services' Indian Health Service denied the claim, and in her decision, claimed that the Tribe owed the Government \$10,774 in overpaid indirect contract support costs for that year. The Tribe appealed the decision.

The parties have now filed a joint stipulation of dismissal with prejudice.

The motion is granted. The appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
