ORDER

An approving official of the Department of the Interior's Bureau of Indian Affairs disallowed costs in the amount of \$2,267,469 associated with a grant awarded to the Crow Tribe by the Federal Highway Administration. The Tribe appealed the official's decision to the Board.

The parties have settled the matter and jointly move the Board to dismiss the appeal with prejudice.

The motion is granted. The appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
