ORDER

The Paiute Indian Tribe of Utah contested the denial by a contracting officer of the Department of Health and Human Services' Indian Health Service of a claim for unpaid contract support costs allegedly due in calendar years 2006 through 2013 under Indian Self-Determination Act contracts. The parties have resolved their dispute and have jointly stipulated to the dismissal with prejudice of the appeal.

Accordingly, the appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
