ORDER

The Seminole Tribe of Florida contested the denial by a contracting officer of the Department of Health and Human Services' Indian Health Service of claims for unpaid contract support costs allegedly due for fiscal year 2013 under an Indian Self-Determination Act compact. The parties have resolved their dispute and have jointly stipulated to the dismissal with prejudice of the appeal.
