Claimant received a demand from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) for repayment of taxes that USACE had paid on claimant's behalf for the benefit of shipping and temporarily storing his household goods when he relocated. Claimant sought review by the Board of USACE's demand.

As of January 27, 2021, claimant paid the debt owed and asked to withdraw his claim, stating that the process was taking too long, he had left the agency, and he had decided to move on. USACE agreed that the debt has been paid in full and that the claim is now moot.

Accordingly, this claim is dismissed.
