Claimant, Todd P., sought review of the demand for repayment made by the agency, Department of Homeland Security, for parking expenses that he incurred and was reimbursed following travel in April–May 2022. By email to the Board’s e-file address on August 26, 2022, claimant advised that he had submitted a payment in the amount demanded by the agency. With claimant’s repayment, there is no longer a dispute regarding whether claimant was required to repay the parking expenses, and the claim before the Board is moot. 31 U.S.C. § 3702(a)(3) (2018).

Decision

The claim is dismissed.
