On May 20, 2024, the Board denied claimant's challenge to the determination by the Defense Finance and Accounting Service that the household goods shipped during his relocation in 2021 weighed in excess of the statutory and regulatory limits, resulting in a debt to the Government of \$2478.48. *Tom K.*, CBCA 8039-RELO, 24-1 BCA ¶ 38,584. On July 1, 2024, the Board denied claimant's request to reconsider the decision. *Tom K.*, CBCA 8039-RELO (July 1, 2024). On July 12, 2024, claimant filed this second request to reconsider our denial of the claim, arguing that our July 1, 2024, decision improperly refused to consider information that could have been, but was not, provided in the prior proceedings.

"The Board's rules do not allow for seriatim reconsideration requests." *Kevin A.*, CBCA 6938-TRAV, 21-1 BCA ¶ 37,771, at 183,337 (quoting *Samuel C. Parshall*, CBCA 6940-TRAV, 20-1 BCA ¶ 37,710, at 183,054). The Board has given the claimant a full opportunity to be heard. We dismiss this second request for reconsideration and will not accept further filings asking us to reconsider our decision on the claim at issue.
