On December 15, 2023, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, pursuant to the authority set forth at 42 U.S.C. § 5189a(d) (2018), filed an application for arbitration with the Board seeking public assistance funding to repair two Shark River inlet jetties in Monmouth County that were allegedly damaged by Tropical Storm Isaias. On January 30, 2024, the applicant filed a notice withdrawing its request for arbitration. Construing the applicant's notice as a motion for voluntary dismissal pursuant to Board Rule 610 (48 CFR 6106.610 (2022)), we dismiss this arbitration. The hearing scheduled for April 5, 2024, is cancelled.
