The Department of the Navy (DON) has filed a request for “help” in “better understanding” the Board’s decision in *Brian G.*, CBCA 8291-TRAV (Mar. 18, 2025). We deem its submission to be a request for reconsideration. *Heather Greenwood*, CBCA 2759-TRAV, 12-1 BCA ¶ 34,988, at 171,989. When an agency or claimant seeks reconsideration of a decision by the Board in a travel or relocation matter, the Board’s rules provide that “[m]ere disagreement with a decision or re-argument of points already made is not sufficient ground for seeking reconsideration.” 48 CFR 6104.407 (2024) (Rule 407). DON expresses disagreement with the Board’s decision and raises the question of how it should apply the Board’s decision in the future. Such an expression of disagreement and asking the Board to address future matters is not a ground for reconsideration.
